FLAX: Use 1.5 to 3.0 gal. Apply by ground sprayer or by airplane.

ESTABLISHED GRASSLAND AND PASTURES: Use 1 to 3 gal. per acre in sufficient water.

CAUSES CHLORIS FOR SEED: Use 1 to 3 gal. per acre in sufficient water to give adequate coverage.

NOTE: In weed control in grasses, repeat treatments may be needed for best results.

RICE AND OTHER CROPS: For control of other broadleaf weeds.

NON-CROP SPRAYING: CANADA THISTLE, WHITE TOP AND MADRONE BUTTERFLY.

CAUTION: Do not apply to water. Do not apply to areas where water is used for drinking.

You are also asked to submit your revised formula statement for your formulation when the EPA action is completed by either the EPA Registration Division (EPA) or Gilmore (EPA Registration No. 42545-1P). You must submit a concrete site-specific formula statement, which must support the use of the product.
