DANGER

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not intended. This product can be used in connection with the Swing Mark V sanitizing system designed for the auto-dispensing of detergent and sanitizing solution of bars and reamers for the sanitizing of glasses, etc. The system is adjusted to deliver 200 parts per million available chlorine. When sanitizing immediately for one minute in a solution of 1 1/2 ozs. (fluid) of this product, followed by a potable water rinse and the immersion sanitized in accordance with health department requirements. dry. Changing of sanitizing solution must be done daily or when the basic measurement 3 Tbsps. or 1 1/2 ozs. product added to 200 available quaternary solution.

Test strength of solution in use periodically with the field test kit. If solution falls below, or exceeds 200 ppm active quaternary, call MARK Serviceman.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Open dumping is prohibited.
- Do not reuse container.
