It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**B-60 National Microbicide** is used to control bacteria, fungi, and algae in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 16 fluid ounces of **B-60 NATIONAL MICROBICIDE** per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 16 parts per million of **B-60 NATIONAL MICROBICIDE** in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosages of 0.47 to 4.0 parts per million of **B-60 NATIONAL MICROBICIDE** should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to collection trays of the airwash system.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and container closed when not in use.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of on a approved waste disposal facility.
