This manufacturing product is not for the direct treatment of pests. Do not use from damaged, punctured or unsealed containers. End-use products formulated from this product must be registered by the US EPA. This product may be used to formulate products for additional uses not listed on this label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with US EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses.
