The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

(1) Add the word "Granular" to your product name to distinguish it from your related powder product.

(2) Delete "It repels the same birds from attacking the crops of grapes, other fruits, grains and nuts," since, according to your June 11, 1984, letter the powder formulation is suitable for these sites.

(3) Under "when first leaves appear" delete "powder or" and change "granular" to "granular."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Sevana Bird Repellent is composed of high quality ground garlic (allium sativum), and ground red peppers. It is used to repel horned larks, house finches, linnets and starlings from attacking the seedling tomatoes, cabbages, radishes, corn, beets, and other crops. It may be applied only at the time of planting and before the crop appears.

It repels the same birds from attacking the crops, fruits, grains and nuts.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

1. At the time of planting: On furrow irrigated crops, apply granular with a granular applicator banded directly in the furrow at a rate of 17 to 20 lbs/ Ac. For sprinkler and drip irrigation, apply at a rate of 25 to 30 lbs/ Ac.

2. When first leaves appear: For additional protection, apply Sevana powder or granular aerially at a rate of 17 to 20 lbs/ Ac. On any field, when first application is by air, apply at a rate of 25 to 30 lbs/ Ac.
