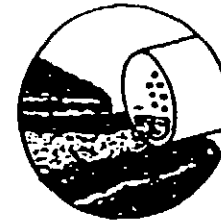

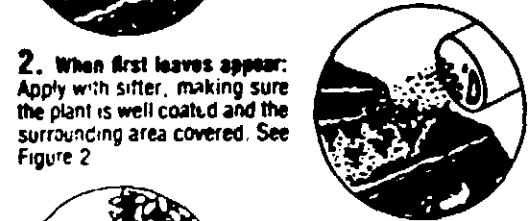
**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Sevana Bird Repellent is composed of high quality, food grade ground garlic (allium sativum), and ground red peppers (capsicum). It is used to repel horned larks, house finches, house sparrows, and starlings from attacking the seeds and seedlings of lettuce, melons, tomatoes, cabbages, radishes, corn, beans, and other vegetables. It is applied at the time of planting and when the first leaves appear. It repels the same birds from attacking the crops of grapes, cherries and other fruits.

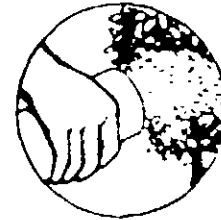
**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**



1. At the time of planting: Apply with sifter on and around the seeded area, or pour as a thin band directly onto the seed line. See Figure 1.

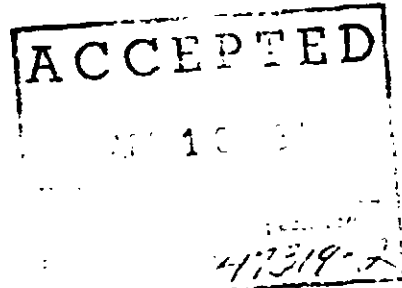


2. When first leaves appear: Apply with sifter, making sure the plant is well coated and the surrounding area covered. See Figure 2.



3. For grapes, cherries, and other fruits: When fruits begin to color or show signs of maturity, use the sifter, throw the powder on as a full coverage to the area that needs to be treated, and

apply as a full coverage to trees and vines. Repeat every 7 days up to 2 days before harvest. See Figure 3.

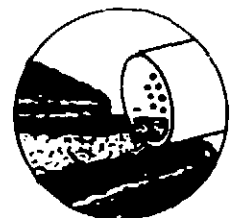

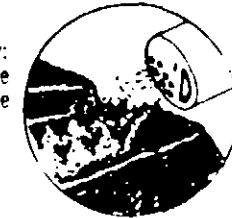
**GENERAL INFORMATION**
