Please submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) reflecting your new malathion source (6720-207).

Your alternate sources of Warfarin are acceptable, however, there could be efficacy problems resulting for the use of alternate CSF's. If one concentrate were to be more poorly accepted by rodents than the concentrate used in testing the product, switching to that concentrate could result in an ineffective bait. Please indicate the composition of the baits formulated for the efficacy data already submitted. This information will help us to determine whether any additional efficacy data would be needed to support the alternate CSF's which you propose to use for your bait.

Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. 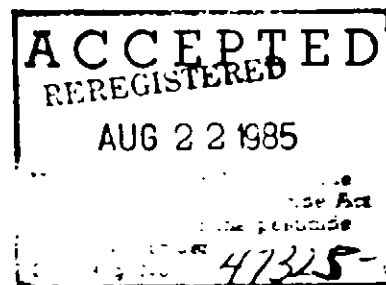

**RATS & MICE:** Replace spoiled bait immediately. Remove all dead animals and dispose of them properly. To prevent reinfestation, clean up spilled water, and harborage. Where a continuous infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
