DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of House mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. Treated baits must be placed in tamper-proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in location where signs of mice have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

HOUSE MICE: Place packages of Dead-End Mouse Killer at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
