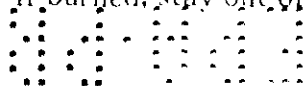

GENERAL INFORMATION

On growing crops: DEAD-END® Pyrethrin Garden and Ornamental Dust may be used on edible crops growing outdoors or in greenhouses up to and including the day of harvest. When used as directed, allowable tolerance levels will not be exceeded.

Apply DEAD-END® Pyrethrin Garden and Ornamental Dust when insects first appear, preferably before damage occurs. Thorough coverage to top and underside of leaves is necessary. Make applications in the morning or evening when the wind is calm. Apply regularly at 7 day intervals or as needed. During humid periods and new growth, apply every 2 or 3 days. Apply with conventional dusting equipment.

VEGETABLES

BEANS: For control of Mexican Bean Beetle, apply 2.5 to 5.0 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BROCCOLI & BRUSSEL

SPROUTS: For control of Flea Beetle and Cabbage Worm. Apply 2.5 to 5.0 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

POTATOES: For control of Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle, Leaf Beetle and Leaf hopper. Apply 2.5 to 7.5 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

TOMATOES: For control of Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle. Apply 2.5 to 5.0 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

WOODY ORNAMENTALS

For control of Eastern Tent Caterpillar and Fall Webworm on APPLE, ASH, CHERRY, ELM, FLOWERING CRABAPPLE, LILAC, OAK, SWEET GUM, SYCAMORE and WALNUT. Dust thoroughly, webs, branches and upper and lower surfaces of all foliage. Apply as needed.
