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- (d) Revise the sentence beginning "Important: Data indicates xx etc." as follows: "Important: Some individuals may develop an allergic reaction (mild rash) following the repeated use of this product or following repeated contact with painted surfaces. Such persons should avoid future use or contact with painted surfaces."

This sentence should follow the sentence "Handle concentrate in a ventilated area."

- (e) Immediately beneath the heading Precautionary Statements add the signal word "Warning."
- (f) The statements of practical treatment section must be headed with:

- (g) Under Precautionary Statements add the following precautions:

When mixing this product for application wear chemical/resistant gloves. When applying this product wear a dust mask (particle mask).

- (h) Under Environmental Hazards the statement should read:

- (i) The directions are unclear with respect to how much product to add to a gallon of paint.
