The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Revise the front panel site limitation "FOR EXTERIOR USE ONLY" to read "FOR EXTERIOR USE ON HOMES ONLY".
 - b. On the front panel, revise "MAYBE IRRITATING" to "MAY BE IRRITATING".
 - c. In the ingredients statement, Inert Ingredients must be in the same type size and style as Active Ingredient.
 - d. Relocate the Translation up to appear directly under the Spanish text.
 - e. As noted in the Agency's May 17, 2001 guidance letter for diazinon registrants, the Statement of Practical Treatment should be revised in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1. When updating this section, be sure to add directly under the heading FIRST AID "This product contains diazinon, an

organophosphate insecticide that inhibits cholinesterase." and be sure to revise the last sentence of the If Swallowed advice by replacing "...an unconscious person" with "...an unconscious or convulsing person". Also, the revised FIRST AID section should include the NOTE TO PHYSICIAN (incorrectly shown as NOT TO PHYSICIAN on your submission). In this relocated Note, revise the sentence about 2-PAM to read as follows: "2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.". The emergency phone number should appear after the NOTE TO PHYSICIAN (as shown on your submission).

- e. As noted in the Agency's May 17, 2001 guidance letter for diazinon registrants, under the heading DIRECTIONS FOR USE directly under "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." you must add **"Reformulation or repackaging of this product is prohibited."**.
- f. Relocate **"Do not use open container except for immediate use. Do not add more than 1 Fl. Oz. To 1 gallon of paint."** to appear at the end of the MIXING DIRECTIONS. When relocating these two sentences, slightly revise the first so that it reads **"Do not open container except for immediate use."**.
- g. Under the heading USE, add "only" after "exterior surface of homes".
- h. Above the heading ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS, add a master heading PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS and a heading HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS with the following associated text (this text incorporates some relocated and slightly revised text from your page 2 including the text identified as IMPORTANT):

WARNING May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. May be irritating to the skin and eyes. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. When mixing this product for application wear chemical resistant gloves. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. When applying this product wear a dust mask (particle mask). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking or eating. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Keep away from food, feed, and water supplies. IMPORTANT: Handle concentrate in a ventilated area. Some individuals may develop an allergic reaction (mild rash) following repeated use of the product or following repeated contact with painted surfaces. Such persons should consult a physician and avoid future use or contact with painted surfaces.

- i. Revise the Environmental Hazards text to read as follows:

This product is highly toxic to fish , birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes,

and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment wash waters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

- j. Under the heading STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, delete "do not store below 10°F (-12°C)." Then add a subheading STORAGE with the following associated text:

STORAGE: Do not store below 10°F (-12°C). Store in a dry, locked area inaccessible to children and pets.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
4. Comply with all applicable provisions of the 2000 Memorandum of Agreement Regarding Pesticide Products Containing Diazinon (i.e., the Diazinon MOA). In accordance with the Diazinon MOA you have requested the following revisions to the conditions of registration for this diazinon product with outdoor non-agricultural (i.e., home and garden) uses:
- a. You have requested under section 6(f) of FIFRA that this registration be voluntarily canceled on a date not later than December 31, 2004.
- b. You may not manufacture, label, or release for shipment this product after June 30, 2003.
- c. You may not sell or distribute this product after August 31, 2003.
- d. The registration for this product shall expire and be canceled on December 31, 2004.
- e. You will send to every person who directly purchases this product (i.e., to every seller) a notification of Product Recovery Program to be conducted by Syngenta and Makhteshim after December 31, 2004.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Please note that the previous source material for your product has been canceled and is no longer registered. Therefore, you must immediately submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) form indicating use of a new replacement diazinon MUP product registered for formulation of diazinon home and garden products. Such diazinon MUP products can be identified by

the inclusion of "HG" in their product names. Please contact your current supplier immediately to find their new MUP product name and EPA Registration Number for the MUP replacement product you can use. Your new CSF should indicate this as a replacement Basic Formula.
