RECOMMENDATIONS:

For repelling terrestrial molluscs such as slugs and snails, apply **STICKEM GREEN** in a continuous 2" band around the trunk of trees, shrubs, or vines. The easiest method for banding trunks with **STICKEM GREEN** is directly from the container at ambient temperature using a stiff brush. The band should be approximately 1/8" thick and applied at a smooth location on the trunk approximately 1' above ground level. The inert ingredients in **STICKEM GREEN** will also serve as a physical barrier to crawling insects such as ants, caterpillars, and beetles (including Fuller's Rose Beetle). Application brush can be cleaned with kerosene or other mineral solvent.

To avoid crawling insects and mollusks from bypassing the **STICKEM GREEN** barrier, trim all branches which touch the ground.
