DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION
For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 fluid ozs) of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each 3500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

- For Pool Maintenance**
- A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.2 range and maintain.
 - B) Add manually or by a loader device this sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.8 to 1.0 ppm. One-half pint (8 fl. ozs) of this solution hypochlorite solution or each 5000 gallons of water will provide 10 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.8 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend upon temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in the proper range.
- NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a Chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive, may cause severe skin irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until odors have dissipated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Treated effluent may not be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters without a valid discharge permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.
