For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. Formulation HS-32Q is extremely versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as soaking. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.


