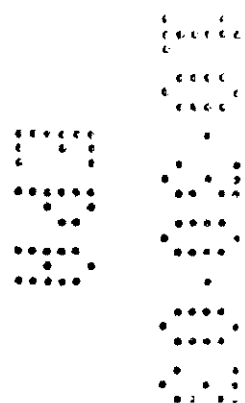

This product is a concentrate for formulating purposes only. This product is for formulation into antimicrobial products for use in/on Agricultural premises and equipment, Food Handling/storage establishment premises and equipment, Commercial, institutional and industrial premises and equipment, Residential premises, Medical Premises and equipment, (Industrial processes and water systems) ~~(Food premises)~~ and Swimming Pools. Formulators using this product are responsible for providing data for the EPA registration of their formulated products. This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator or primary registrant has complied with U.S. EPA data requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage
