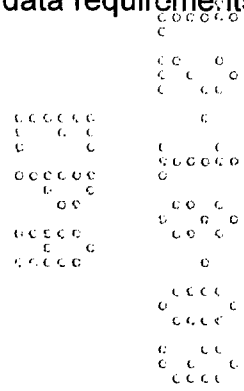
PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

JAQ Powdered Quat is a cationic germicide. Do not mix with soap or anionic materials.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is a concentrate for formulating purposes only. This product is for formulation into antimicrobial products for use in/on Agricultural premises and equipment, Food Handling/storage establishment premises and equipment, Commercial, institutional and industrial premises and equipment, Residential premises, Medical Premises and equipment, Industrial processes and water systems and Swimming Pools. Formulators using this product are responsible for providing data for the EPA registration of their formulated products. This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator or primary registrant has complied with U.S. EPA data requirements regarding the support of such use(s).



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage:

Open dumping is prohibited. Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.

Pesticide Disposal:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Container Disposal:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying.

Plastic and Metal Containers ≤ 50 lbs:

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Plastic and Metal Containers > 50 lbs:

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

(Fiber Drums with Liners:) Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
