*from alpha-(p-nonylphenyl)-omega-hydroxypoly(oxyethylene) and polyethoxy polypropoxy polyethoxy ethanol-iodine complexes

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician.

Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

If swallowed, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

May cause severe eye irritation or eye damage. For eyes, wear goggles or face shield when handling the concentrate. Causes skin irritation. Wear rubber gloves when handling the concentrate. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food, water, or animal feed. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge to lakes, streams, ponds, or other public waterways without an appropriate NPDES permit. For NPDES permits, contact your regional Environmental Protection Agency office or the appropriate agency in your state.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

FIBER DRUMS WITH LINERS

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, burn. If burned, stay out of smoke.
