

Formulation HS-8451P

Directions for Use in Eating Establishments:

All sanitizers shall have indicated on the product label the directions for sanitizing multi-use eating and drinking utensils. These directions shall be printed in a numbered outline form as follows:

1. Scrape and pre-wash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner (a commercial cleaner or detergent can be recommended).
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water (195 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

NOTE: A clean potable water rinse following sanitization is not permitted under Section HSS 196.13 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Manufacturers of approved products will be permitted to use the statement on their label that their product was "Approved under the regulations of the Wisconsin State Division of Health".
