The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - Delete the term "General Classification" from the label.
2. We have determined that this product is subject to Child-Resistant Packaging regulations (effective March 9, 1981). Refer to 40 CFR 162.16 "Pesticides Requiring Special Packaging" and the *Federal Register* Vol. 46, No. 41, Tuesday, March 3, 1981, pp. 15104-15109, "Clarification of Policy Issues on Special Packaging," for guidance and proper submission requirements.

You must submit a statement certifying that your packages meet the standards for special packaging for this registration.

However, you may wish to voluntarily restrict your product to use by service persons only which would not require child-resistant packaging. To do this, you must print on the label, or temporarily apply as a sticker on the label or on the container for all sizes in which this product will be marketed, the following statement:

Only for Sale To, Use and Storage by Service Personnel.


This statement must be at least the same type size as the child hazard warning statement and preferably placed in the upper front panel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

No-Wax Floors — cleans floors bright with virtually no filming or dulling the gloss. And 1/4 cup of Formulation HS-5210 to 1/2 pail (1 gal.) warm water, wash floor with sponge or mop and rinse.

Waxed Floors — use same as above, usually not necessary to rinse.

Bathroom/Kitchen — porcelain, sinks, toilet bowls, bathtubs, refrigerator, appliances, countertops, painted woodwork, and walls, just add 1/4 cup to 1 gallon warm water and rinse. Apply with cloth or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For heavily soiled areas, a precleaning step is recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

MILDEWSTATIC INSTRUCTIONS

Formulation HS-5210 will effectively inhibit the growth mold and mildew plus the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous inanimate environmental surfaces such as walls, floors and tabletops. Solution (1/4 cup to 1 gallon of warm water) with a cloth, mop or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application weekly or when growth reappears.

Didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride. 4.85%

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician immediately. If swallowed, drink promptly a quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.
