DIRECTIONS

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

USES: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, showers, conductive flooring, and lavatory fixtures. For institutional use only such as hospitals and nursing homes, schools and colleges, medical and dental offices, veterinary clinics, & Federally inspected meat & poultry plants.

APPLICATION: Use 4 ounces per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. Versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as soaking. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

FLOOR & WALL CLEANER: For use in federally inspected meat & poultry plants as a floor & wall cleaner in all departments. Before use of this compound, food products & packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. Apply with mop, cloth, or sponge @ a dilution of 4 oz. per gallon of water. After use of this compound, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with a potable water rinse.

TO CLEAN & DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS

To clean, squeeze around the bowl & up under the rim. Leave for 10 minutes or overnight if possible. Swab, then flush. Stubborn stains may require brushing. To disinfect use 1 fl.oz. & brush surfaces. Close safety cap after use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician immediately. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

CORROSIVE: May cause eye irritation or eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food, water, or feed. To protect eyes, wear goggles or face shield and to protect skin, wear rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap & water after handling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

—Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer to recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

FIBER DRUMS WITH LINERS

Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

METAL CONTAINERS

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer to recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

GENERAL

Consult federal, state or local authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
