DIRECTIONS GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USES: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior built surfaces, empty basins, showers, conductive flooring, and lavatory fixtures. For institutional use only such as hospitals, and nursing homes, schools and colleges, medical and dental offices, and veterinary clinics.

APPLICATION: Use 2 ounces per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross dirt and heavy soil or grease. Then thoroughly wet surfaces. Versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as spraying. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

To protect eyes, wear goggles or face shield and to protect skin, wear rubber gloves when handling the concentrate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

- Open dumping is prohibited.
- Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:
