**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

HS-267Q is a concentrated, multi-purpose germicide designed to kill bacteria up to 400 ppm hard water (calcium carbonate) in the presence of 5% organic matter. HS-267Q kills germs, cleans, and disinfects in one step. HS-267Q is effective against the following organisms according to ADAC tests:

- Pseudomonas aeruginosa*
- Staphylococcus aureus*
- Salmonella choleraesuis*
- Trichophyton trichophyllum*
- Aspergillus Type 2*
- Herpes*
- Influenza A/Texas*
- Herpes simplex*

USE: Floor, walls, tile, surfaces, painted surfaces, ceiling, floor surfaces, etc. For cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing. For industrial use only such as hospitals, and nursing homes, schools and colleges, houses and hotels, etc. Do not use on food surfaces.

APPLICATION: Use 2 ounces per gallon of water for a maximum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross soil and heavy soil deposits. Then thoroughly wet surfaces, normally and can be applied with a mop, sponge or cloth to wall or ceiling. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Approved by USDA for use in cleaning green and poultry plants as a floor and wall sanitizer in all circumstances. Food products and feeding materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. All surfaces must be stored with plastic water.

DILUTION: 1:64 1/4 cup per gallon of water 2 OUNCES PER GALLON OF WATER

No-Wax Floors — cleans floors bright with virtually no filming or dulling the gloss. And 1/4 cup of Formulation HS-267Q to 1/2 pail (1 gal.) warm water, wash floor with sponge or mop and rinse.

Waxed Floors — use same as above.

Bathroom/Kitchen — porcelain, sinks, toilet bowls, bathtubs, refrigerator, appliances, countertops, painted woodwork, and walls, just add 1/4 cup to 1 gallon warm water and rinse. Apply with cloth or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IRRITANT**

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL PLASTIC CONTAINERS**

**PLASTIC CONTAINERS (Capacity less than 1 gallon)**

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or purchase and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**PLASTIC BRUSH WITH BRISTLES**

Completely empty brush by soaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Thoroughly rinse with application equipment. Then dispose of brush in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If brush is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

**METAL CONTAINERS**

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or purchase and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

**GENERAL**
