**DIRECTIONS FOR USE  
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

**USES:** Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, showers, conductive flooring, and lavatory fixtures. **APPLICATION:** Use 2 ounces per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. *To clean/disinfect toilet bowls: To clean, squeeze around the bowl rim under the rim. Leave for 10 minutes or overnight if possible. Sumb, then flush. To disinfect first remove all debris over the inner trap the residual bowl water prior to applying the use-dilution. Use 2 fl. oz. of concentrate and subm the bowl completely using a scrub brush or mop, making sure to get under rim, and let stand for 10 minutes, then flush.*
