**No-Wax Floors** — cleans floors bright with virtually no filming or dulling the gloss. Add  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup to  $\frac{1}{2}$  pail (1 gal.) warm water, wash floor with sponge or mop and rinse.

**Waxed Floors** — use same as above, usually not necessary to rinse.

**Bathroom/Kitchen** — porcelain, sinks, toilet bowls, bathtubs, refrigerator, appliances, countertops, painted woodwork, and walls, just add  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup to 1 gallon warm water and rinse. FORMULATION 56-P will effectively inhibit the growth mold and mildew plus the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces such as walls, floors, and table tops. Apply solution ( $\frac{1}{4}$  cup to 1 gallon of warm water) with a cloth, mop or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. <sup>let air dry.</sup> Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application weekly or when growth reappears.
