The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions listed below.


- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1
- Revise as per other PR Notices

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. The Agency has completed risk assessments to characterize Didecyl Dimethyl Ammonium Chloride (DDAC). During this process, the acute toxicology profile was determined for Manufacturing Use Products (MUP) with an active ingredient concentration ranging from 40% to 80%. According to this data, this product is classified as follows:

Primary Eye	Tox I
Primary Skin	Tox I
Acute Inhalation	Tox II
Acute Oral	Tox II
Acute Dermal	Tox III
Sensitization	Yes



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Thus revise the Precautionary Statements to read exactly as follows:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if inhaled or swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breath vapor. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C). Wear protective eyewear (goggles or face shield), protective clothing and rubber gloves. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash throughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

- 2. Revise the "First Aid" statements by adding "If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."
- 3. Under "First Aid," bold the subheadings, If swallowed/If in eyes/If on skin or clothing, so the statements stand out on the label.
- Under the "Directions for Use," delete the use sites, "aquatic areas" and "public access 4. premise." Your label needs to be more specific in terms of the sites which will be treated. In addition, delete the following sites which are not supported for this active ingredient: "materials and preservatives" and "antifouling coatings."
- 5. The statement which follows the product name is too broad. The Agency is moving toward revising MUP labels to list the specific sites at which a product may be formulated for use, not the pesticidal claims associated with those uses. Revise the statement: "For Formulation into Antimicrobial Products" to read: "For use by manufacturers only in formulating antimicrobial products for the uses indicated on the label."
