

Revise Precautionary statemement as follows"

May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed thorough skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water .

- 2. Under the "Storage and Disposal" add the statement "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage".
- 3. Your label includes the sites "other institutions" and "sick rooms". The listing of these two sites implies that this product is for use in hospital settings. According to DIS/TSS-1 the following organisms are required to support hospital use of a disinfectant: Salmonella choleraesuis, Stalphylococcus aureus, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. Your label does not list any of these organisms, thus
