HS 210 Mildew Preventative prevents musty odors and discoloration due to mildew, fungi and molds. For use on laundering fabrics. Provides a residual bacteriostatic finish against odor-causing bacteria in laundered fabrics. HS-210 Mildew Preventative helps control most odor-causing bacteria and helps provide a fresh smell. It will inhibit the growth of bacteria and reduces the number of bacteria from wet contamination.

For use in laundering fabrics in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, colleges and other institutions. For use in sanitizing diapers, institutional linens and athletic apparel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not intended by the manufacturer.

MILDREW PREVENTION Reduces the growth of mildew. For 1 week protection, use 1 1/4 oz. per 100 lbs. of dry weight fabric. Retreat as necessary.

Dilute appropriate amount of HS-210 Mildew Preventative in one to two gallons of water; then add to the washwater in the final rinse (minimum rinse cycle time of 8 minutes) retreat fabric after each washing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. 
