**WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** is for use as a preservative in industrial-type products such as soluble cutting fluids and coolants. **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** is an effective in controlling fungi and bacteria. **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** is used in metal working operations.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS**

**WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** is readily incorporated into cutting oil fluids by addition to the concentrate with moderate agitation. It should be added to the concentrate to provide 200 - 400 ppm in final use emulsion. **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** can also be incorporated into the final use emulsion at a level of 200 - 400 ppm.

**WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** is completely compatible with most of the common use base ingredients and concentrates. Dilutions of emulsifiable concentrate containing **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** are stable when diluted with from 5 - 100 parts of water.

Add 4.5 oz. (0.34 lbs.) of **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** to each 100 Gallons (830 lbs.) of Final Water Use Emulsion. To Treat Concentrate Prior to Dilution, Add 4.5 oz. (0.34 lbs.) **WFT-78 MICROBICIDE** to Each One Gallon (8.0 lbs.). This mixture may be diluted to 100 gallons maximum with water.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**
