M-2205 FARM SANITIZER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR SANITIZING POULTRY DRINKING WATER:

DILUTION: 1 ounce per 11 gallons of water.

Regular use of M-2205 Farm Sanitizer helps to keep the waterers free of slime and minerals.

Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations.

For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment food utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard surfaces. Do not rinse. Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, then apply a solution of 1 ounce of M-2205 Farm Sanitizer in 5 1/2 gallons of water.

Apply to sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush. Do not rinse.

DAIRY USE: The udders, flanks, and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 oz. M-2205 Farm Sanitizer in 5 1/2 gallons of warm water. Do not rinse.

Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil. Do not dip used towel back into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.

Before use in federally inspected meat and poultry food processing plants and dairies, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. A potable water rinse is not required following use of this compound on previously cleaned hard surfaces provided that the surfaces are adequately drained before contact with food so that little or no residue remains.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

GENERAL
