Formulation POQ 1210 is for use on hard non-porous surfaces in households. Formulation POQ 1210 is effective against odor-causing bacteria.

Mildewstatic Performance.

Formulation POQ 1210 will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat weekly or when mildew growth returns.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For disinfecting apply Formulation POQ 1210 to walls, floors, garbage cans, and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, bathroom fixtures, and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces for a contact time of 10 minutes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when used solution becomes visibly dirty.

KITCHEN . . . Kitchen floors collect both traffic dirt and germs. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water, or full strength anywhere greasy dirt is a problem.

BATHROOM . . . Great for cleaning and deodorizing basins, tubs, and tiles. Leaves everything bright and clean . . . kills odor-causing household germs. Odors disappear instantly. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water, or full strength where odors are a problem.

FOR CLEAN, FRESH, HYGIENIC LAUNDRY/DIAPERS . . . For extra cleaning power plus deodorizing action, add 1/2 cup Formulation POQ 1210 with regular soap or detergent. Makes laundry fresh and odor free . . . especially good for grimy work clothes. For stubborn stains and spots, pre-dampen with full strength Formulation POQ 1210 before adding to wash load. To kill odor-causing bacteria in diapers, pre-soak in 1/2 cup Formulation POQ 1210 per gallon of water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
