# JAQ Swimming Pool Algicide

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### General Use Directions

**APPLICATION:** For all applications, apply equal amounts along pool edges around the circumference of the pool. Circulate or stir water for uniformity throughout the pool.

**INITIAL APPLICATION:** For a pool with visible algae present add 3 ounces per 10,000 gallons.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Use 3 ounces per 10,000 gallons every week. For very hot weather or heavy bathing load, use this dosage every 5 days.

**BOOSTER DOSE:** After heavy rains or severe storms add 1 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water.

**WINTERIZING DOSAGE:** After heavy rains or severe storms add 1 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water.

**POOL-SIDE SURFACES:** Pool-side surfaces should first be cleaned with a recommended detergent product.

**2 TABLETS:** For use in skimmers, flaters, automatic chlorinators, float canisters, or float ring.

**1 TABLETS:** Use for refilling canisters or in skimmers.

**STICKS:** For use in pressure chlorinators or widgee chlorinators.

**NOTE:** Before entering the pool, check the quat residual, allow pool to stand until below 2.0 ppm.

For use as an algae growth depressant. Keeps pool water free of visible algae and slime. Improves filter operation. Compatible with most pool treatment chemicals. Will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastics. Efficient and stable. Totally water soluble.

Recommended for use in institutional and household pools.

Effective against *Chlorella pyrenoidosa* (green algae), *Phoridium retzii* (blue-green algae), *Phoridium inundatum* (blue-green algae), *Lyngbya versicolor* (blue-green algae), and other swimming pool algae.
