



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner ^{Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg. No.} inconsistent with its labeling. Aged or infirmed people should be removed from the room before spraying.

For disinfecting: Clean surface to be disinfected. Hold sprayer about 6 to 8 inches from surface and spray until surface is thoroughly wet for a contact time of 10 minutes. No dilution necessary.

To deodorized use as a space spray: Spray upwards toward center of the room. The number of trigger strokes will depend on the size of the room and severity of the odor problem. No dilution necessary.

MILDEWSTATIC PROBLEMS

Formulation RTU-6075 will effectively ^{precleared} inhibit the growth of mold and mildew plus the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous inanimate environmental surfaces such as floors and walls. Apply by spraying surfaces until thoroughly wet. Let air dry. Repeat application
