Dear Mr. Sloan,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions listed below.

# **Proposed Amendment**

Update as per PR Notice 2001-1 and PR Notice 83-3.

#### Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Based on other similar product in the marketplace, the statements regarding the hazards posed by the product to humans and domestic animals are incomplete. Such statements appear under the section heading "Precautionary Statements." Revise the Precautionary Statements by replacing the existing language with the following language:

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS [emphasis added]

CAUTION. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wear protective eyewear, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing before reuse.

If you do not agree with this precautionary language, please provide or cite toxicology data to t language that you believe should appear on the label.

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italics to the do-not-use statement:

Do not use on utensils, glassware, dishes and appliance interior surfaces as a disinfectant.

4. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" section for container sizes one gallon or less, by adding the following words listed in italics:

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in trash or recycle.

5. Revise the language regarding the disposal of metal containers under the "Container Disposal" section for container sizes greater than one gallon to include the words in italics:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

6. The last accepted label provided instructions for the disposal of fiber drums with liners. If the product is packaged in fiber drums with liners, then please reinsert the language that was previously included on the label. That is:

(Fiber Drums with Liners): Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.



# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Aged or infirmed people should be removed from the room before spraying.

FOR DISINFECTING: Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits. Preclean all surfaces prior to disinfection. Hold sprayer about 6 to 8 inches from surface and spray until surface is thoroughly wet for a contact time of 10 minutes. No dilution necessary. Let air dry or wipe dry.

Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food such as countertops, appliances, tables and stovetops with potable water before reuse. Do not use on utensils, glassware and dishes as a disinfectant.

(Note to reviewer: Only One of the following two statements will be used:)

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

MILDEWSTATIC INSTRUCTIONS: Will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew plus the odors caused by them when applied to precleaned, hard, nonporous environmental surfaces such as floors and walls. Apply by spraying surfaces until thoroughly wet. Let air dry. Repeat application weekly or more often if growth reappears.
