DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PVP Iodine Solution FE-150 is to be used to impregnate absorbent clays to inhibit the growth of odor-causing bacteria. Application rate is approximately 0.2 lbs. of active titratable Iodine per 2,000 lbs. of clay (15-16 lbs. of 1.28% titratable iodine solution per 2,000 lbs. of clay).
