


In support of this amendment, enclosed are the following:

Dantocil HG preserves and aids in the control of objectionable bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, soft soaps, room deodorizers/air fresheners, water-based surfactants, polymer emulsions, water-based gels for household/industrial products and textiles.

Dantocil HG should be added to the formulation to be preserved at a rate of 0.2% (2,000 ppm) based upon the total weight of the product to be protected.

To ensure uniform distribution, slowly disperse Dantocil HG into product with agitation. Mix thoroughly until evenly dispersed throughout product.

(If container size is 1 gallon or less, the following storage and disposal statements will be used:)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

(If container size is greater than gallon, the following storage and disposal statements will be used:)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Keep from freezing. Keep this product in the original container when not in use.
