Lonza is submitting a *Notification of change in mixing directions per PR Notice 98-10, section II.M.1.*The requested change to the label is the replacement of the phrase "per gallon of water" with the phrase "per gallon of *deionized* water" in the Citrus Canker Disease Control directions.


