

PREVAIL has been formulated to aid in the reduction of cross-contamination in institutions, schools and hospitals. **PREVAIL** is a one-step disinfectant-cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal, fungicidal, and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed. **PREVAIL** is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces.

When used as directed **PREVAIL** will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause mal odors.

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PREVAIL is a one-step cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-fungicide-mildewstat-virucide. It is effective against moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply **PREVAIL** to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection — To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces in hospitals, add 2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use-level **PREVAIL** is also virucidal, fungicidal and mildewstatic. At 1 oz. per gallon **PREVAIL** will disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in schools, industry and non-medical institutions.

Sanitizing — To sanitize porous or non-porous, non-food contact surfaces, add 1/2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 30 seconds.

For hospitals and nursing homes, add 2 oz. per gallon of water. The broad spectrum of **PREVAIL** has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following organisms by the AOAC Use-Dilution Test:

- Staphylococcus aureus*
- Salmonella choleraesuis*
- Escherichia coli*
- Serratia marcescens*

AOAC Fungicide Test

PREVAIL at 1 oz. per gallon is an effective fungicide against Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise facilities, etc.

Mold and Mildew Control

At 1 oz./gallon **PREVAIL** will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard non-porous surfaces as indicated in general instructions above. Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance

At 1 oz. per gallon use-level, **PREVAIL** was evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against influenza A/Brazil Virus on inanimate environmental surfaces.

For schools, non-medical institutions and industrial use: At 1 oz. per gallon of water, **PREVAIL** delivers excellent cleaning and germicidal effectiveness. It is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Escherichia coli*. The same AOAC tests used above to confirm suitable performance for hospitals were used.

Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.): At 1/2 oz. per gallon use-level **PREVAIL** is an effective sanitizer against *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Klebsiella pneumoniae* in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.
