

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner in-

AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE is used to treat algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be treated with AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 4 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a free pool initially 4 to 7.5 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13.6 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with algae growth require an initial dose of 8 to 16 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water. For hot tubs, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, or ponds with algae growth, add 8 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE should be made every 7 days for maintenance.

AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools not treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 6.5 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 7.6 fluid ounces of AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algaecide in the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE is compatible with chlorine and is used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both low and high chlorine levels. AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE can be used in pools with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals. However, do not mix AQUARIUS ALGAECIDE with chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Lacking or defective container should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spilled product. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and pets.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container for disposal.
