- Purpose**            The purpose of each submission under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is to revise your label, to increase the additional package sizes/net contents for the above products.
- Review**            All of the proposed additional packages sizes meet or exceed the minimum application amounts approved for claims of control of both rats and mice.

**Conditions of Approval**

This registration is not consistent with the Agency's May 28, 2008, "Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides." EPA anticipates cancellation of those existing products that are not consistent with the Risk Mitigation Decision to occur no later than June 4, 2011. In the meantime, EPA is approving new registrations and amendments to existing registrations of rodenticide bait products, on a time-limited basis, so long as the registrations do not present greater risks of unreasonable adverse effects than existing products. Accordingly, this registration is approved only subject to the condition that the registration shall expire on June 4, 2011. This condition of registration may be amended in conjunction with amendments to conform to the Risk Mitigation Decision. Absent such amendments, product released for shipment by the registrant after June 4, 2011, would be in violation of FIFRA.

**Label**

For each product, the labeling submitted with the above letter is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship the product.

Under "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL", revise your "Disposal" text [Household Label] and revise "Container Disposal" to "Container Handling" [Non-Household Label] followed by instructions for each type of container. In general, you will be adding the new text required by the "Container Regulations" (40 CFR 156.140 - .159) and explained in PRN 2007-4 to the existing container disposal instructions.

We have suggested an acceptable text in Enclosure 2. Contact us if you need assistance in developing correct text. Also, all products distributed or sold in nonrefillable containers will need batch codes on the label or the container.

**Consequence for non-compliance**

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of these product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
