1. Revise your "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**" according to Enclosure 1.

- 5. Move the following sentences to the end of the section in their own paragraph, for emphasis:

Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than 16 pounds of bait. [Professional Use Sublabel]

In the meantime, EPA is approving new registrations and amendments to existing registrations of rodenticide bait products, on a time-limited basis, so long as the registrations do not present greater risks of unreasonable adverse effects than existing products. Accordingly, these registrations are approved only subject to the condition that the registrations shall expire on June 4, 2011. This condition of registration may be amended in conjunction with amendments to conform to the Risk Mitigation Decision. Absent such amendments, product released for shipment by the registrant after June 4, 2011, would be in violation of FIFRA.
