

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 2 ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas - mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 2-3 ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water. Rinse surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, restrooms, etc., mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 1½ ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot. All soiled surfaces must be precleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Those surfaces in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality. Do not reuse used solution.

To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of TC-160 in 3 gallons of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot. All soiled surfaces must be precleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Do not reuse used solution.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard non-porous surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot. All soiled surfaces must be precleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with food or grease should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water, and then mopped with a solution containing 2 ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water before disinfection. Do not reuse used solution. This solution is effective against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied upon when tuberculocidal disinfection is required.

DEODORIZATION

Prior to deodorization of bathroom areas, garbage pails, diaper pails, food storage areas, kennel areas, etc., remove all garbage, refuse, food and/or animals. Preclean surfaces using pressure cleaning. To deodorize, mop or brush surfaces thoroughly with a solution containing 2½ ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water.

SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls, floors and other hard non-porous, non-food contact surfaces in the presence of a mold or mildew, mop or brush with a solution containing 4oz. of TC-160 per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. All surfaces that are heavily soiled must be precleaned prior to sanitization (follow directions for cleaning).

To sanitize hard non-porous food contact surfaces such as equipment and utensils, mop or brush with a solution containing 2½ ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted surface for 60 seconds. All surfaces must be precleaned with a detergent followed by a potable water rinse (or follow directions for cleaning) prior to sanitization. Rinse with potable water before reuse. Do not reuse used solution.

MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL

To control mold and mildew on previously cleaned glass, metal, plastic, tile and other hard non-porous surfaces, mop or brush with a solution containing 2½ ounces of TC-160 per gallon of water so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. Allow to dry. Repeat weekly or when growth is visible. Do not reuse used solution.

This product may be used to control pathogenic fungi, mold and mildew, and as a general purpose anti-bacterial detergent in homes, schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms and other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.
