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DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

Ground Squirrels, Richardson's Ground
Squirrels, and Thirteen-lined ground Squirrels
along feed borders or ditch banks during a 3-
month period after squirrels emergence from
hibernation (April-June). Use rolled oats or
barley as a prebait and apply over the area at a
rate of 4 lbs per acre 2-4 days before providing
RIDALL-Z. This should increase bait
acceptance. Broadcast in 20 ft swaths using
hand or ground driven equipment at a rate not to
exceed 4 lbs per acre. Apply bait in the mid-
afternoon so most animals will expire in their
burrows. Do not broadcast near homes where
feed or feed is grown or on roads. Consult
wildlife authorities for local regulations. In right-
of-way, bait may only be applied between the
bottom of the ditch and the property. Always bury
excess bait left in the equipment. For control of
Meadow and Field Voles, prebait the infested
area by broadcasting rolled oats or barley at the
rate of 4 lbs per acre 2-4 days before applying
the bait. Apply the bait in 20 ft swaths at a
rate of 4 lbs per acre. RIDALL-Z is 20 ft swaths at a
rate of 4 lbs per acre.

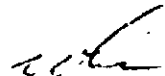
