Use on floors, walls, tubs, shower stalls, toilets, kitchen sinks, diapers, laundry, and other non-food contact surfaces throughout the house. Wax, crayon marks, and greasy grim or films are easily removed. Use throughout entire bathroom: basin, tub, shower, floor and toilet. Destroys odors instantly. Thoroughly wet all surfaces with Pine-Breeze 105 to insure effective disinfection. Pine-Breeze 105 leaves the breath of fresh forest aroma wherever it is used.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE-

CLEANING, DISINFECTING AND DEODORIZING-

Use 1/2 cup of Pine-Breeze 105 to 1 gallon of warm water. Apply with sponge, mop or cloth to floors, walls, cabinets, appliances, countertops, tubs, sinks, shower stalls, garbage pails, chrome fixtures, diaper pails and hamper so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. Let stand 10 minutes or until air dry. Prepare fresh solution for each use.

TOILET BOWLS-

Pour 1/3 cup of Pine-Breeze 105 directly into bowl water. Use brush, mop, or swab to scrub entire inner bowl surface. Let stand 10 minutes for disinfection. Flush.

FAMILY LAUNDRY/DIAPERS-

For a fresh smelling laundry, add 1/2 cup of Pine-Breeze 105 with regular soap or detergent per laundry load to deodorize towels, blankets, work clothes, and linen to leave family laundry clean and fresh-smelling.
