Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of spray equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide, spray, mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

BACK PANEL

ON ANIMALS:

To protect animals from horn flies, house flies, mosquitos and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair but not soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control bloodsucking lice, apply the spray lightly to infested areas using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two to three weeks, as required.

BARNs, STABLES, PIG CONFINEMENTS, MILK & EGG HANDLING AREAS OF DAIRIES & CHICKEN HOUSES.

To control flies, gnats, mosquitos, apply as a fog or fine mist directing the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the enclosure until the space is filled with mist using 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close windows and doors before spraying and keep closed for ten or fifteen minutes. Remove animals before spraying enclosed areas. Vacate the area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat application if necessary.
