

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. (HEARTLAND) HIGH REPELLANT WIPE has been specially developed for use on horses. It provides long lasting protection against insects while imparting a high lustre to the coat. Apply by either soft cloth or trigger sprayer.

WIPE ON:

First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen. Make a light application. Do not wet the skin. After application, brush out to bring the coat to a shiny lustre. Repeat as required.

TO USE AS A SPRAY:

Fill a bottle equipped with a trigger spray with High Repellent Wipe without diluting. Spray lightly over the coat. Do not wet the skin. Brush after application.
