PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
Contents under pressure. Do not use or store
near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or in-
cinerate container. Exposure to temperatures
above 130°F may cause bursting.

Read the entire label carefully before use. This prod-
uct is a general purpose spray with its labeling.

DISPOSAL
Spray into a plastic container and put in
trash.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright,
nozzle away from you. With nozzle 10 to 12 inches
away, direct spray over the animal, beginning at
the tail, spray over the animal until the entire
coat is damp up to the back of neck. On long-
haired dogs and cats, ruffle the coat and spray
against the lay of hair, spraying directly be-
hind hand so that spray reaches skin. For best
results in controlling tick infestations, locate
ticks and spray directly on them. Avoid spraying
face and genitals. An application of 30 to 45
seconds is usually sufficient for an average
size dog; for cats about 10 seconds is adequate.
Repeat application weekly if necessary.

Do not use to treat or cause exposure of kittens
or puppies less than four weeks old.

In kennels and other sleeping quarters to control
fleas, ticks and to deodorize the quarters, spray
walls and furniture as above and spray bedding,
walls, cracks, crevices and flooring as often as
necessary.
