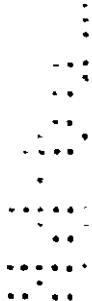

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid contamination of food and food-stuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas when food is exposed. Pets should be removed and fish aquariums covered during treatment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED-Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to any unconscious person.
IF INHALED-Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.
IF ON SKIN-Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
IF IN EYES-Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F (58°C) may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Use at least one can for each 6,000 cubic feet of space. Additional units should be used for areas where mist will not flow. Close all doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all open flames except pilot lights (Keep can at least six feet from pilot light). Place can in middle of the room on a table or floor. Place several pieces of newspaper under can to prevent marring of surface. Keep at arms length when releasing. Do not point top of can toward face or eyes. Push down the tab of the actuator at top of can until it locks. Set can down on the prepared surface and leave the building immediately. Keep undisturbed for at least 2 hours. After treatment open doors and windows and ventilate thoroughly for 1 hour. Do not allow children to lie or sleep in treated areas until at least 6 hours following treatment. Asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected when in contact with products. Cover asphalt tile with newspaper and remove or cover plastic furniture, stereo covers, eye glasses, etc. before treatment.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Delete "Exposed" from the front panel claim.
2. INERT INGREDIENTS must appear in the same type size, style and alignment to the left margin as ACTIVE INGREDIENTS.
3. Revise "Additional units should be used for areas where mist will not flow" to "Additional units should be used for remote rooms or areas where free flow of mist is not assured. Additional airing-out time is required for these same areas."
4. Relocate "Asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected when Cover asphalt tile with newspaper and remove or cover plastic furniture, stereo covers, eye glasses, etc. before treatment." to appear immediately after "...to prevent marring of surface." This will consolidate similar directions and have directions presented in correct sequence order.
5. The correct company address, Industry, CA, should appear instead of Walnut, CA.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.
