

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with these directions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame.
Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DAIRY FARM USE: Milking Parlor and Milk Room: Close all windows and doors, spraying for 2-3 seconds for 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Do not remain in treated area after treatment. Cover milking utensils and milk to prevent contamination or killing insects.

ANIMAL USE: Thoroughly spray entire animal from approximately 2 ft. directly toward animal's eyes. Spot treat withers, shoulders, and back with from head to tail.

STANCHION BARN USE: Walk behind animals and direct spray over backs of animals. For most effective results, apply each morning.

POULTRY OPERATIONS: In poultry houses, close all windows and doors, spraying for 2-3 seconds per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Do not remain in treated area. After spraying, treat daily or as necessary.

ANIMAL USE: For animal application, direct spray over backs of hogs per hog. Do not spray directly toward the animal's face or eyes. Repeat as necessary.

HORSE BARN OR STABLES: In horse and pony barns, close all windows and doors, spraying for 2-3 seconds per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Do not remain in treated area. Repeat the application as necessary.

ANIMAL USE: For animal application, lightly mist over back of horse at a distance of 2 ft. Do not spray directly toward the animal's face or eyes. Repeat as necessary.

BEEF CATTLE OPERATIONS: In barns, close all windows and doors, spraying for 2-3 seconds per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Do not remain in treated area. After spraying, repeat application as necessary.

ANIMAL USE: For animal application, thoroughly spray entire animal at a distance. Do not spray directly toward animal's face or eyes. Repeat as necessary.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANT USE: To kill roaches, spiders, silverfish, etc. Spray the insect directly when possible. Spray all probable hiding places, baseboards, sinks, cabinets, shelves, under appliances, in to Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths. Close all windows and doors, spraying for 1-2 seconds for 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area after treatment.
