ANIMAL USE: For animal application, lightly mist over backs of horses at distance of 2 ft. Do not spray directly toward the animal's face or eyes. Repeat as necessary.

BEEF CATTLE OPERATIONS: In barns, close all windows and doors. Spray for 2-3 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Do not remain in treated area. After 15 min. Repeat application as necessary.
