

air-washing systems that maintain effective concentration. To its use, systems should be cleaned of deposits. An initial slug dose of 7.1 WATER TREATMENT BIOCIDES per gallon

is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until conditions of 4.8 to 11.9 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water should be employed. Frequency of addition depends upon the nature of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not stack more than four drums high. Use drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust and disposed of in a sanitary landfill when not in use.
